

Requirements of sponsorship and accreditation of a meeting by the ESNR:

1) Definition of sponsorship:

That a Congress, Course or Meeting is labelled as "**Sponsored by ESNR**" means that the ESNR supports this event as a meeting of sufficient scientific level that could be of interest for neuroradiologists.

This implies that:

- The topic is diagnostic or interventional neuroradiology or the topic is in neurosciences with an emphasis or special accent on diagnostic or interventional neuroradiology.
- Speakers invited to cover the neuroradiological topics are members of the ESNR or are renowned neuroradiologists.
- The participants are neuroradiologists or "neuroscientists" with a special interest in neuroradiology.
- The participants are members of ESNR, possible future members of ESNR or possible future students of ECNR.

2) Application:

To apply for sponsorship a letter has to be written to the general secretary, mentioning the detailed scientific program of the meeting and the list of speakers as well as the targeted audience. The application has to reach the general secretary in time so that he can discuss the request with the other members of the board. In practice this means by preference at least six months before the event. It is recommended to apply in the same time for accreditation.

3) Practical benefit:

The organizers can mention on their program, leaflets and posters "sponsored by the ESNR" and can use the logo of the ESNR on these documents. The scientific events "sponsored by ESNR" will as such be accredited by the ESNR.

2.- Accreditation:

That a Congress, Course or Meeting is "**Accredited by ESNR**" means that the ESNR agrees to accredit this event after receipt of an official request by the organiser in the way explained on the website.

This will lead to the attribution of UEMS-CME credits that will enhance the attractiveness and the scientific recognition of the meeting. Again it is essential that the general secretary receives the necessary documents in time. ***The ESNR will take care of the financial aspects of the accreditation.***
